Schedule of the Programme :

The NEP orientation and sensitization programme will be an eight day programme, with two live online sessions of 90 minutes each based on the eight NEP-2020 themes starting from Wednesday to Friday (Week 3), Monday to Friday (Week 4). MCQs will have to be completed by the Saturday of each week which will comprise 5 questions related to themes.
