

## Pedagogy

The programme will be conducted in online mode through interactive and technology-enabled teaching methods. The pedagogy will include online lectures, expert talks, discussions, PowerPoint presentations and audio-visual learning materials. Participants will engage in webinars, assignments, case study discussions and interactive question-answer sessions. The course aims to promote interdisciplinary understanding, critical thinking and awareness regarding environmental challenges and sustainable development.

## Schedule of the Program :

The Short Term Training Programme (FDP) will span 06 working days, featuring two live online sessions. The evaluation method in the programme will be an MCQ consisting of 20 questions which every participant will have to qualify.
